This Seventh PAMinSA meeting, dedicated to the late Dr. Marvin Allison, will be held in the Panamericana Hotel in Arica, Chile, from October 25 to 27, 2017.

With less than one month left before our meeting, we want to thank all the researchers and students who submitted their abstracts and who have expressed their interest in participating in this event. Thanks to your enthusiasm, PAMinSA has an excellent series of presentations scheduled.

All conference activities will be carried out at the Panamericana Hotel in Arica. Presentations for podium and open communication sessions will be held in the Pacific Lounge and the poster session will be held in the Tarapacá Salon.

We are pleased to inform you that we will have simultaneous English-Spanish/Spanish-English translations, which will be available during the podium presentations and the open communication sessions.
